**Waste:** Household Recycling Centres are located at Horton Wood 50 and Halesfield 1. Open every day 9 - 5pm except Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years day. Dependent upon type of vehicle used (eg trailers and vans), you may require a permit to dump waste. There is a collection service for anyone unable to transport bulky items, charges start at £18. If you are 65 and over, you can have one free bulk collection a year.

**Defibrillator:** A unit has been provided for use of residents, and visitors to the Parish. This defibrillator is located at the rear of The Huntsman Inn and is designed for any lay person to use following simple spoken instructions.
